**REPORTS:**

Programs (Reg Hofmann)

- Today's speaker is Alan Wallace from the City of Saskatoon, Community Services Department. He will be doing a presentation on City Planning for now and the future of Saskatoon.
- The D.L. (Distinguished Lecturer) has been set up for November meeting. His name is Julian Debullet.

Treasurer (Bruce Waldbillig)

- Financial figures were given of the current balances. An audit was done for the past two years and given as to be in good standing; with minor abnormalities. The meal plan will not change for the current year. The cost of each is given as follows:
